Eligibility Requirements: The Schwandt – Kastle Future Leader Scholarship is available to any Thunder Ridge student graduating from Thunder Ridge High School in the current academic year. Applicants must attend a two or four year public or private accredited college or a vocational/technical college. The scholarship is a onetime award of \$1,000.00 payable directly to your educational institution. **Payment of the scholarship will be awarded after successful completion of your freshmen year of college and upon enrollment in your sophomore year.**

Upon completion of your freshmen year – a certified college transcript needs to be sent to the Thunder Ridge High School Counselor. A minimum of a 2.0 GPA must be attained in your freshmen year.
